



Photography contest in the Street

Intro: One of our tasks as Street workers is "making the invisible visible" and giving voice to the people we accompany. Therefore, we propose this photo contest, to show the world's streets, to incorporate the habitant's look into the technician's gaze.

Pictures: Each entry will consist of a collection of 3 pictures of sufficient quality to be printed on paper and sent as JPG files.

Topic: The Topic is the street, what you see and what is not seen, situations of injustice or solidarity actions captured. Pictures must be performed by children, youth and adults within the public space.

Participants: You can participate individually or collectively.

Pictures must be presented in attached with a short text (title and context description). There should be clearly displayed the authors names, their contact details and other information such as your age, neighborhood, etc ... Each paper will be presented by an organization of Street Workers Network.

Deadline: 30th January 2012.

The organization will publish the photos, and then a competent jury (photographers, artists and educators) will choose the 3 best collections among the ones presented. In 2012 there will be an exhibition to all participants.

Award winner: all participants will receive a diploma and the possibility to have virtual and presence in the picture collection exhibition.

The 3 selected winners will receive a photographic material pack.
